We will be studying three motets by German composers from the late seventeenth and early eighteenth centuries, namely Johann Sebastian Bach ('Singet dem Herrn', SATB/SATB), Johann Christoph Bach ('Unsers Herzens Freude hat ein Ende', SATB/SATB) and Johann Kuhnau ('Tristis est Anima mea', SSATB.) Johann Christoph Bach is arguably the most important member of the Bach family before Johann Sebastian Bach. Kuhnau was Johann Sebastian Bach's immediate predecessor as Thomaskantor in Leipzig.

Joe Crouch was a chorister at Westminster Abbey and a choral scholar at King's College, Cambridge. He subsequently studied baroque cello at the Royal Academy of Music. He is now principal cello at the Academy of Ancient Music, the Gabrieli Consort and Players and the English Concert and plays with The Sixteen. He has numerous teaching roles including the Guildhall School of Music and Drama and the Royal Academy of Music and a research fellowship at the University of Southampton. We are delighted to welcome him as a new tutor for TVEMF.

Applications are invited from singers and continuo players (keyboard, cello, double bass, violone, bass viol, bassoon, theorbo). **Pitch will be A=415.**

The fee is £16 for Early Music Forum members and £20 for non-members. There is a £3 reduction if you download the music yourself (78 sides). The link is on the website. Applications should be made by 21st September.
